3 **SECTION 1. DATE FOR APPLICATION OF FEDERAL FOOD,**
4 **DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT TO DEEMED TO-**
5 **BACCO PRODUCTS.**

6 Section 901(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cos-
7 metic Act (21 U.S.C. 387a(b)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “This chapter shall apply” and
2 inserting the following:

3 “(1) IN GENERAL.—This chapter shall apply”;
4 and

5 (2) by adding at the end the following new
6 paragraph:

7 “(2) DEEMED TOBACCO PRODUCTS.—For each
8 tobacco product deemed subject to the requirements
9 of the Act pursuant to paragraph (1), each reference
10 in sections 905(j) and 910(a)—

11 “(A) to ‘February 15, 2007’, shall be con-
12 sidered to be a reference to ‘the effective date
13 of the regulation under which a tobacco product
14 is deemed subject to the requirements of this
15 Act pursuant to section 901(b)(1)’; and

16 “(B) to ‘21 months after the date of enact-
17 ment of the Family Smoking Prevention and
18 Tobacco Control Act’, shall be considered to be
19 a reference to ‘21 months after such effective
20 date’.”.
